



ROAD RALLY AND OFF ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2017

1. All contenders must be fully paid up members of **Llandysul Motor Club**.
2. To qualify as a contender in the club's championships the following conditions must be abided by:
 - members must join before the 31st March 2017 (points will be awarded to members who join after this date at the discretion of the committee).
 - members must attend at least two club night/ social events throughout the year.
3. The Championship year begins on 1st January 2017 and ends on 31st November 2017. The 2018 championship (and subsequent years) will begin on the 1st December 2017 and finish on the 31st November 2018. All events held within that period will be eligible for points.
4. Contenders must enter all events (national B status or above) under **Llandysul Motor Club**. Entering under two clubs will not be accepted. Closed to club events will still be eligible for points. Llandysul Motor Club events are exempt from the club championship.
5. The championship co-ordinator will allocate points as soon as they are in receipt of the qualifying events entry list and final results sheet.
6. It is the contender's responsibility to inform the championship co-ordinator of their results as soon as possible. Contenders have two calendar months from the date of the event in which to inform the championship co-ordinator of their results. Points from results handed in after this time will be awarded at the committee's discretion only. **No discussion** will take place with regards to this
7. The club will run two different championships where the best six events will be eligible for points:
 - a) Road Rally: There will be two classes in this section
 - Class A will be for contenders who are eligible for the masters and expert class
 - Class B will be for contenders who at the start of the year are eligible for the semi-experts and novice class.
 - Road Rally Awards:
 - 1 Plaque for Overall driver and Trophy
 - 1 Plaque for Overall navigator and Trophy
 - 1st in Class receives Plaque and Trophy
 - 2nd in Class receives a Trophy only
 - 3rd in Class receives a Trophy only
 - b) Forestry and Tarmac: it is open for contenders to enter any event.
 - Forestry/Tarmac Awards:
 - There will be one Trophy for best Driver and one Trophy for best Navigator.
8. On all Championships the points system will be:
 - 20 points for first club contender home
 - 19 points for second club contender home
 - 18 points for third club contender home etcEach championship contender will receive two points for starting an event, even if he/she is a non-finisher. (Starting an event is receiving an actual time at MC1). Competitors who compete in a trophy rally will receive ½ points i.e. 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd etc.
9. If there are less than 4 competitors in a class then an award will only be presented for 1st in class. If there are less than 6 competitors in a class then 1st and 2nd in class awards will be presented. If there are 6 or more competitors in a class then awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class.
10. Driver and Navigator points will be kept separate.
11. If the results of the club championship become a tie the championship co-ordinator will defer to the committee who will decide on an acceptable resolution
12. A copy of the championship rules will be available for inspection on the club website.
