**FINAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Thank you for your entry on this year's Classic Tracks Targa Event, sponsored by Spencer Environmental Care Associates Ltd, West Wales Rally Spares and Garej Windy Corner.

**Competitors**

Your Competition Number is as per entry list.

Please ensure your Marshal is aware of your competition number prior to signing-on.

The Competitors' Briefing will take place at 10:15am and it is vital you attend as important information on the day's event will be shared with you during this time.

**Start / Finish**

The Start Venue is located at West Wales Rally Spares, (6fig.Map146, 403 419), Noise at Ysgol Bro Teifi (Map146, 406.5, 421), Scrutineering at Gwasg Gomer (Map 146, 404, 419.5). Trailer Park is located at Jones & Davies (Map 146 , 412.5, 411) and you park here at your own risk. On completion of the Noise and Scrutineering go promptly to the start venue and follow the instructions of Marshals to your parking spot .

The Finish Venue is located at the Porth Hotel, Llandysul (6fig.Map146,418 407 ). Please be considerate of local residents and keep the noise to a minimum as you travel through the village to the finish venue.

Noise, Scrutineering and Signing-On will open at 7:30 am and close at 9.30am promptly. Any competitor not signed-on by 10am will be **excluded** and a reserve will be offered their place. The event runs on a very tight schedule and it is vital that you adhere to these times.

Please remember that if you are an existing club member then you will need to produce a valid Llandysul Motor Club membership card at signing-on. If you have joined with the entry or are joining on the day then you will be provided with a membership card at signing-on.

Also, for those drivers who are running under the Jelf Insurance Partnership Scheme and are under 20 you must produce a Jelf Letter on the day. Any queries can be made to the Entry Secretary (Beryl Hands 01559 363314).

All outstanding fees (membership & insurance) will need to be paid at signing –on and only CASH will be accepted.



## Entries

Competitors are reminded of the following:

“Entry fees will be refunded, less £15 administration costs, if the competitor cancels their entry before the closing date of the entry list. After that the entry fee will be refunded at organiser’s discretion.”

The closing date of the entry list is 23:59 hrs on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2017.

## Marshals

Marshals signing on will open at 7.45am and all Marshals are expected to be signed on by 9:45am.

This year all controls will be allocated on a first come first served basis and no pre-booking of controls will be allowed unless your Marshal is manning more than one control (in this case they need to contact the Chief Marshal prior to the event: Sion Jones 07967140178).

If your Marshal wants an early control then they need to turn up early!! Your Marshal may be asked to man a Passage or Time Control dependant on what controls are left to fill. Also please remind your Marshal that controls are located on Tests which are on farm tracks therefore they need to be well prepared for the conditions (especially if the weather is bad). Your Marshal will need to make sure they have the following: pens, clipboard and fluorescent jacket/tabard (not supplied).

Any Marshal failing to man their control during their appointed time will result in exclusion for the competing crew. **NO MARSHAL – NO START.**

## Route

The navigational form of this event will be a photocopied route book which will be handed out at MC0 (located in the Signing-on area). MC0 will open approximately 10 minutes after the Competitors' Briefing.
